

Invitation – Makeup Artists

Dave McKeen, retired telecom engineer, invites emerging and experienced professional makeup artists to participate in photo sessions at my studio on a TFP/Testing basis. I work with new face and experienced talent in a *trade for CD* exchange to help me build my portfolio. I completed seven semesters of photography study at Richland College in Dallas. I photograph dedicated, dependable female talent 3-29 who are passionate about their craft and are interested in developing their portfolios and in headshots with impact.

Are you about to graduate from makeup school? Just graduated and don't know how to get started? Already well established but would like to enhance your portfolio? Work with me in photo sessions with new face and experienced talent in the DFW area. I do my work TFP (TFCD, actually), which means it's free to the talent. Depending on your experience, you can begin working TFP and on a Test basis or charge the talent for your work. With TFP you do as closely as possible what the model wants and with Testing you have the model's permission to include experimentation on your part. You get a CD with retouched, print-resolution images from the shoot. If you charge the talent you can either charge a nominal fee (\$50 - \$75, whatever they can pay) or the going professional rate. My offer applies to your working TFP or for the nominal rate.

Photo sessions are light hearted, high spirited, and laid back. Photos are captured in high resolution digital imaging. The location for most sessions will be at my place in Garland. My theme is "Talent Portfolio Development", so what you and the model need will work for me! Look around my Web site as much as you can. It should give you a good comfort level with what the setup and my shooting style are like. I'm open to shooting other styles too, so I am not constrained by what you see on the site.

If you are interested in this opportunity I can furnish more details and help you create a model release form.

NOTE: Prints-ready images will bear the photographer's copyright symbol. I retouch my final cut of photos to high resolution print quality before a Web photo gallery is made of them. I don't give out unprocessed camera images. I process only those photos I consider flattering to the model and which represent me as a professional photographer.
